First reading of the following changes to Rules/Bylaws:

VI.L.2. Match play will be postponed if <u>in-person instruction at</u> Jefferson County Public Schools is canceled or delayed unless both teams agree to play. The host team will notify the club.

IV. B.5.b. Mandatory Move Up Teams. Any returning team which won its division in the previous year, and any team which achieved a 75% or higher winning percentage of **possible points** in the prior year must move up one division, if that team returns a majority of its players from the prior year.

2. A recent college player who played or committed to play tennis at a Division I,II,III or NAIA college and who is younger than 26 years of age at the beginning of the league year must roster in the <u>A1 division or higher</u>.

BYLAWS

Article III.

2. Election and Term of Office

Officers are elected by the board of directors. Each officer shall hold office until her successor shall have been duly elected and shall have qualified or until her death or until she shall resign or shall have been removed in the manner hereinafter provided. The officers of the corporation for the upcoming league year shall be elected every year by the board of directors at a meeting held no later than May 31. If the election of officers shall not be held at such meeting, such election shall be held as soon thereafter as shall be convenient. Vacancies may be filled, or new offices created and filled at any meeting of the board of directors. Term of officers may be reelected for successive terms, but no person other than the Treasurer shall hold an office for more than three successive terms. Past Presidents will rotate off of the Board for a minimum of three years.
